Dee's Childcare is a day care in SE London, Woolwich/Plumstead Area.

Dee's Childcare was founded in 2001 by the owner Decima Isles-Broughton in her home, as a small childminding business that grew with demand from other parents who heard about the wonderful services Dee's Childcare was offering.

Over the years, the business expanded and now, Dee's Childcare operates from a newly refurbished setting offering care in a bright, clean, safe and homely environment for children 7 months to 11 years.

Dee's Childcare offers a truly all-inclusive package to parents, giving you the peace of mind that while your children are in our care, they benefit from the highest level of childcare.

We believe in collaboration and the power of community.

Therefore, to facilitate even more educational experiences to the children in our care, we have associated with Lingotots Bexley, to bring weekly French lessons in the day-care for those who are interested.

We visit Plumstead Library for weekly sessions of Story and Rhyme Time, Soft Play and borrowing books to take home.

Recently we have secured a private weekly class at Europa Gymnastics Centre designed to help children develop their co-ordination and gross motor skills.

We are also participating in the Healthy Early Years London awards scheme funded by the Mayor of London which supports and recognises achievements in child health, wellbeing and development in early years settings.

In order to achieve the awards we have managed to secure coach Kai from Sport Stars Superstars who will be delivering weekly PE sessions for the children in the daycare.

We work in partnership with parents and seek to support, nurture and encourage that special relationship. We understand that, on occasion, there are end of day pressures that means parents simply don't have time to discuss their child's progress.

Recognising this, we use Baby's Days, a secure online portal to enable parents to follow their child's progress, view their picture gallery or, perhaps, just to watch a video of messy play that day.

Daily general updates are also provided on our 'Signal' Parents Forum.

Dee's Childcare offers a truly all-inclusive service, all year round offering Holiday Club during half Terms and Summer Break.

At this time, we have availability which could potentially suit your requirements and we would be happy to welcome you and your child into the Dee's Childcare extended family. Outlined below are the initial key elements of our admissions policy and procedure, should you wish to progress further.

Opening Hours: 7.30am till 6.30pm Monday to Friday.

All children must be collected by $6.30 \, \text{pm}$ a late collection fee of £10.00 per 15 minutes (or part of) is payable. (Earlier or later hours can be arranged at an additional fee of £10.00 per hour).

Registration Fee: There is a non-refundable registration fee of £75.00.


Reservation/Retainer Fee: There is a non-refundable fee (2 weeks payment) to reserve a daycare place for 6 weeks or more.

Payment Deposit: We require a payment deposit of £400 refundable to you when you give the required one month's written notice to terminate your Daycare place.

Fees: Our fees are very competitive for the area and can be calculated hourly, daily, weekly or monthly based on individual needs. Fees are payable for ALL contracted days including sick days, parent holidays, bank holidays, parents days off, and staff training days. Fees are payable monthly in advance and payments are due on the 1st of each month.

Late payments incur a £10.00 daily late fee.

Unsocial hours (outside of normal working hours) **£10.00 per hour**Contracts can be Full Time, Part Time, Term Time* or Casual* (*incurs an additional retainer fee)

We accept Childcare Vouchers, offer the 15 & 30 hours free entitlement and Together4Twos. You may also wish to contact Tax Credits https://www.gov.uk/child-tax-credit/new-claim to check your eligibility.

Holidays: Three weeks paid holiday, (usually two weeks over Christmas, one over Easter). At least Four weeks prior notice will be provided



Dee's Childcare offers a high standard of care for children aged from 4 to 11 years.

The **After School Club** operates from 3:00pm to 6:30pm, 5 days a week, during term-times, and during holidays.

The children are provided a healthy and nutritious snack after school.

They are encouraged to participate in various activities including homework hour, science experiments, cooking, arts and crafts, board games, quiz & movie night and fitness Fridays.

We also take them on trips to the library, allotment, parks, cinema, museums, funfair and ice-skating at Christmas time, all to ensure that their social, emotional and educational needs are supported.







As well as our after school club during term time we also run **Holiday Club** for all ages which is filled with days out to parks, woodlands, gardening at the allotment and a few special trips to museums and the sea side.

Lots more activities on offer in the day care- outdoor play in our enchanted garden, water play, sensory den, soft play area, mud kitchen, arts and crafts, games and puzzles.

- Provide a child-centred play environment for children aged 4 -11 years.
- Provide a range of exciting and fun activities that stimulates the children to learn through play in a safe and secure environment.
- Provide an environment where children can develop their skills and foster peer friendships.
- Develop relationships with the community at large so as to provide a service that is relevant to the community and which reflects the dynamics of the community.
- Provide a community-based Club that is accessible, affordable and inclusive.
- Create an atmosphere which promotes and encourages the children's creativity, self-confidence, self respect and independence.
- Provide quality care in a friendly, caring and fun environment that meets the needs of the children, parents and carers.

Living with Covid-19 @ Dee's Childcare

- Any pupil, staff member, parent or visitor with Corona virus symptoms must not attend nursery and must isolate at home.
- Increased cleaning processes are in place, throughout and at the end of the day
- Arrival and departure: parents please sanitize before entry and remain in the lobby area for the hand-off and pick up.
- Parents are required to maintain the social distancing rule and should therefore wait outside if the reception area is busy.
- Parents will not visit the nursery rooms unless this is explicitly arranged with the Nursery Manager e.g. in the event of a child being distressed.





Dee's Childcare is the place where children learn, play and grow. This is our motto. This is the forefront of setting up any space for the children in our care.

Our new setting is newly refurbished into a clean, warm, homely space. We've created a bright natural learning environment with open ended natural resources. Furthermore, we benefit from an enclosed enchanted garden for Forest Childcare Experiences.

Each of our rooms are bright and airy, age specific, in compliance with National Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) Curriculum and directives.

We've created a special room for each age group which we fondly name:



Caterpillars: O-2 years old



Cocoons: 3-4 years old



Butterflies: 5-11 years old





Within each room are curriculum based areas, corresponding to the EYFS seven areas of learning, as well as an area for sleep and quiet time, and plenty of space to play.

Butterflies have access to a computer station and quiet area to complete homework.

All children gather in the main dining area at meal times or collective activities and have the opportunity to socialize, help each other and play together.

Settling in/transitions

- Parents may enter the daycare for the purpose of settling-in sessions, if not doing so would cause a child distress.
- The Manager will give further guidance on the day regarding the duration of the settling in sessions after discussing with the parents the needs of each child.
- It is important that social distancing continues to be maintained.



Routine

During the nursery day we aim to provide the children a wide range of activities which enables them to build a variety of new skills.

Our daily schedule is generally divided as follows:



- Morning session could be an adult led activity, an outing, story and song time, morning snack and outdoor play in the garden
- Lunch
- Nap time/Quiet time



 Afternoon session consists of interaction with all age groups children, free play, child led play, afternoon snack and outdoor play in the garden.

We are also currently offering French lessons in partnership with Lingotots Bexley, Soft Play @Plumstead Library, GymTots @ Europa Gymnastics Club, Crayford, and Physical Education (PE) in association with Super Star Sports.

These are paid for sessions and parents can opt for their child to participate and are required to pay all fees. Full details will be provided prior to the even.

The sessions are term time only and we do change the days they are delivered termly to give all the children the opportunity to take part.

Children thrive on routine and consistency and we are dedicated to create a positive environment where children feel secure, safe and loved.



Aside our daily time in the fresh air and the exercise that comes with it, we also believe in providing nutritious, delicious food, freshly cooked on site, by our in-house chef. Children in full-time day care can receive up to 90% of their daily food intake from our meals. We recognise that a nutritious and balanced diet helps set the foundations for lifelong food preferences, making it essential that children eat well during their formative years.

As part of our commitment to providing the children with a healthy diet, our menus, you will notice are mainly plant-based, created in conjunction with the Change4Life website.

The staff are currently working towards the Healthy Early Years London Awards. HEYL is an awards scheme https://www.london.gov.uk/what-we-do/health/healthy-early-years-london funded by the Mayor of London which supports and recognises achievements in child health, wellbeing, and development in early years settings.

General information about our menus

Food Safety

Food is stored, prepared and presented in a safe and hygienic environment.

All the staff preparing and handling food have gained a Food Hygiene Certificate.

We also insist to teach children basic hygiene skills, such as not eating food that has fallen on the floor, and washing their hands with soap and warm water before eating meals or snacks and after going to the toilet or playing in the outdoor area.

Plant based

We have such a love for nature and all things coming from it, which enhance the children's learning and growing experiences. To this end, we grow our own vegetables at the allotment. Our menus favour a more plant based selection.

Drinks

We offer plant based milks and fresh drinking water which is available and easily accessible throughout the day.

We are a forest childcare provider and a great believer that children learn best outside the classroom when they are free to explore, take risks, and build resilience.

Outdoor learning provides countless opportunities for children to develop problemsolving skills, self-exploration, decision-making skills, healthy living awareness, creativity, and imaginative thinking whilst learning to understand and love their natural environment. We provide weekly visits to our allotment and now at our new day care, we have our very own enchanted garden equipped with various play areas and plant beds.

It's a great opportunity for the children to get involved in growing our own vegetables, understanding where our food comes from and learn about, appreciate and care for the environment and the creatures that live in it.



We have created an outdoor classroom in our garden.

Outdoor education and play support emotional, behavioral and intellectual development. Studies have shown that students who learn outdoors develop: a sense of self, independence, confidence, creativity, decision-making and problem-solving skills, empathy towards others, motor skills, self-discipline and initiative.













The attached sample of our weekly plan clearly portrays that one of the key things that sets us apart from other childcare providers, is our commitment to providing weekly opportunities to take our children out into the community.









At Dee's Childcare we value parents as partners and understand the importance of this relationship in ensuring that your child thrives, both emotionally and academically, whilst in our care. Using Baby's Days the most advanced, interactive child care management system available, we provide daily updates on your child's progress and achievements.

baby's days

Baby's Days allows us to form this partnership with you, simply and effectively. When you connect to our system you will be able to view numerous areas of the system including Daily Notes, Toileting, Sleep Times, Progress, Photograph Galleries, Policies, Permissions and Invoices etc. Within the Daily Notes you can read about your child's daily activities and leave comments for us to read and respond to. Within the Progress section parents can read Progress and Observation notes, view photographs and see exactly what development level you child is currently at. In addition, you can read, agree to, and digitally sign acceptance of our Policies and Permissions and also view and print your weekly/monthly invoices. But best of all, the system is fully interactive enabling you to add/share photos and observations of your child's achievements at home, therefore, providing a complete development record between home and your childcare provider






Considering that close to 8% of an OFSTED inspection grades the effectiveness of the parent partnership, it is imperative that we form a good working partnerships with all of the parents of the children in our care. We must be able to communicate a steady flow of information regarding your child's progress, activities, development and more and be able to demonstrate how we do this during our inspection.

We also use a messaging app called Signal where we convey quick messages between the parents and the staff. We have a Parent's Forum and specific groups for Caterpillar's, Cocoons and Butterflies.

After accepting a place please download the app so that we can add you to the groups.





Working in partnership with our parents and families is at the forefront of the organisation.

We recognise that parents are their child's first educators and aim to build solid, open, and honest partnerships with them by involving parents and carers from the very first visit to the Daycare, transition period, settling in, and daily chats, to sharing of resources, communications, social events, and information sessions.

We will work together to provide the support needed to develop children to fulfill their potential at each stage of their development.

For a successful partnership, we need the same effort on both sides, therefore, we encourage the parents to participate actively.

We welcome all occasions where we can spend time together and celebrate the children, the parents and the staff.

We organise annual events such as **Christmas Winter Wonderland**, **Easter Fun Day** and **Summer BBQ** where all the families are invited.

The Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) is the framework followed by all early years settings following the British Curriculum. This is a child centred curriculum, which places play and exploration at the forefront of the child's learning journey.

The EYFS framework guides staff to provide meaningful learning opportunities across the 7 areas of learning and development, outlined below:

Communication and Language Development

Children are given opportunities to experience a rich language environment, to develop their confidence and skills in expressing themselves. They speak and listen in a range of situations.

Physical Development

Children are provided with opportunities to be active and interactive, to develop their coordination, control and movement. Children begin to understand the importance of physical activity, and to make healthy food choices.

Mathematics

Involves providing children with opportunities to develop and strengthen their skills in counting, understanding and using numbers. They calculate simple addition and subtraction problems and describe shapes space and measure.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Children develop a positive sense of self, forming positive relationships with others. develop social skills and learn how to manage their feelings. They understand appropriate behaviour in groups, and have confidence in their own abilities.

Expressive Arts and Design

Children explore and play with a wide range of media and materials, as well as providing opportunities and encouragement for sharing their thoughts, ideas and feelings. They experience art, music, dance, movement and role play.

Literacy Development

Children begin to link sounds and letters and begin to read and write. Children are given access to a range of reading materials (books, poems, and other reading materials) to ignite their interests.

Understanding the World

Involves guiding children to make sense of their physical world and their community through opportunities to explore, observe, and find out about peoples, places, technology and the environment.

These 7 areas are used to plan your child's learning and activities. The professionals teaching and supporting your child will make sure that the activities are suited to your child's unique needs. This is a little bit like a curriculum in primary and secondary schools, but it's suitable for very young children, and it's designed to be really flexible so that staff can follow your child's unique needs and interests.

Children in the EYFS learn by playing and exploring, being active, and through creative and critical thinking which takes place both indoors and outside.

As a mum or dad, how can you help with your child's learning?

All the fun activities that you do with your child at home are important in supporting their learning and development, and have a really long lasting effect on your child's learning as they progress through school.

Even when your child is very young and is not yet able to talk, talking to them helps them to learn and understand new words and ideas. If you make the time every day to do some of the following things with your child it will make a real difference to your child's confidence as a young learner.

Dee's Childcare has been a part of the local community for almost 20 years.

Therefore, we have built strong relationships with other local services to provide the children the best experiences to enhance their learning.

We work in close partnerships with many local children centres, libraries, schools, nurseries and some small independent businesses.

We are regular visitors to Plumstead Children Centre and Library, Thamesmead Library where we attend playgroups, singing and story time sessions.

We do school runs for Notre Dame Primary School, Eglinton Primary School, Plumcroft Primary School and Foxfield Primary School.

Lingotots Bexley, offers language lessons and for more than 5 years we have affiliated with them to bring this opportunity to the children in our care. Once a week, a tutor comes to the day care and delivers a French lesson for the children whose parents wish them to attend, due to the additional cost.

Prior to Covid-19 restrictions we also participated in the Lingotots Generations programme, where sessions were held in a local elderly care home, where the children interacted with the elderly residents.

Starting this year we have been working with two great companies to provide the children more opportunities for learning and developing.

Super Star Sport who are delivering weekly PE classes in our daycare.

Europa Gym Club in Crayford where we attend Gymtots once a week.
